Schuylkill will hold fall cleanup program

The annual fall cleanup program sponsored by the Schuylkill County Commissioners will be held the weeks of Sept. 21 and 28 this year, it was announced by Chairperson Mantura Gallagher.

The Tamaqua Transfer Station, located along Sewage Plant Road, will participate beginning Monday, Sept. 29, through Friday, Oct. 3, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily and Saturday, Oct. 4, from 7 a.m. to noon.

Items which will be accepted and the fee schedule for them was announced as follows:

Electronics: television sets, microwaves, computer systems, etc., \$5 each. (Note: computer system includes one monitor, one hard drive, one printer and or scanner and peripherals); Single monitor, hard drive, printer, etc., \$2 each; single peripheral, no charge.

Tires: Only automobile, light truck and motorcycle/RV tires up to 16-inch diameter are accepted at \$1 per tire without rims; \$2 per tire with rims

Appliances: freon bearing air conditioners, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, \$5 each; non-freon bearing items and scrap metal, such as stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, bicycles, barbecue grills and metal furniture, no charge.

Bulky items: mattresses, box springs, rolls of carpet, doors and windows, \$5 each; sofas, overstuffed chairs, \$5 per cushion (example: love seat, two cushions, \$10).

Household hazardous waste: paints, solvents, cleaners and poisons will not be accepted. Questions concerning disposal of such items should be directed to the Schuylkill County Office of Solid Waste and Resource Management, 628-1220.

For disposal of any of the above items, proof of county residency must be provided.
